Keep Calm and... start your own business!

An enthusiastic young car mechanic has used the demise of a 40-year-old company to start his own business.

Time-served Ford technician Nathan Barber was one of more than 80 people who lost their jobs when stricken family firm Holiways went into administration in August. But instead of moping about, the 22-year-old former Woodham Academy student initiated an ambition to start his own business.

Nathan is now running MotorFix Auto Repairs, from Unit 1 at Brighthouse Court on Burtree Road, Aycliffe Business Park.

"I always wanted to set up on my own, and after what happened with Holiways it seemed like a good time to do it," said the former Byerley Park School pupil.

"The Holiways owners had it for 40 years, they've been for a long time, so it wasn't good for anyone."

Solid growth on Aycliffe Business Park

Valad, the European multi-let real estate investment manager, has completed 250,000 sq ft plus of lettings and sold over 100,000 sq ft of industrial and office space at Aycliffe Business Park (ABP) over the course of the last 18 months.

Valad were advised by Jones Lang LaSalle, Sanderson Weatherall and Morganfield Developments who act as joint agents on the park.

ABP is the second largest business park in the North-East, covering about 672 acres and is home to over 250 companies, with firms including Husqvarna, Katell, Raisco, A-Tech Fabrications, Finley's, BTS, DPE

Automotive and most recently Group Homesafe Ltd, who recently completed the acquisition of circa 20,000 sq ft on Redworth Way. Jonathan Simpson, partner at Sanderson Weatherall, said: "The level of take up on the park over the last two years has been excellent. "This has helped us significantly decrease the voids across the estate which is a great result for the fund investors. Perhaps the concern now moving towards 2013 will be the shortage of good quality stock, particularly with Hitachi now firmly on the horizon."

Council's £182m savings on target

An update on Durham County Council's Medium Term Financial Plan outlines how, despite continued uncertainties regarding Government funding, the council's plan remains on target to deliver the third year of required savings.

Council leader Cllr Simon Henig said: "To date we have hit very tough savings targets for 2011-12 and 2012-13. Short of further unprecedented announcements, 2013-14 also looks set to deliver the budget cuts required."

Holiways for sale

The former Holiways car showroom has gone up for sale for just under £2m. The collapsed family-owned Ford dealership went bust in August, with a loss of more than 80 staff.

The showhome and land - totalling 27,502 sq ft (2,555.02 sq m) - has gone up for sale for £1.95m with Sanderson Weatherall.

Ebac's £1m bid

Newton Aycliffe-based Ebac has put in a £1m bid to the Government's enterprise fund as part of plans to become the UK's only manufacturer of washing machines.

The firm wants to start building washing machines and fridge-freezers, creating another 200 North-East jobs.
